### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

1. Fill out the application form and all other necessary forms. Submit with all other required documents.
2. After having completed all necessary forms, the school will notify about entrance exam, come to school on entrance exam day.
3. Discuss entrance exam results and have interview with the Principal.
4. Based on the entrance exam and interview results, the ward(s) placement in the school will be determined.
5. If the grade is full, the student(s) will be placed on the waiting list until a space opens up.
6. Following the parents' interview, you will be asked to:
  - ☞ Sign "Parent's Contract."
  - ☞ Pay the Admissions Fee.
  - ☞ Pay one semester's tuition and all other fees.
7. When all fees and documentation has been received, admissions letter will be sent to parents for admissions.

### **ENTRANCE EXAM OR ASSESSMENT**

#### **Pre-nursery to Nursery I (18 months to 24 months)**

Pre-nursery and Nursery school students will take an assessment.

#### **Montessori Kindergarten (3 years to 5 years)**

KG students will take a Literacy Skills and Maths Concepts assessment and Life Skills.

#### **Primary School (Cambridge)**

Primary School students will take an English and Maths entrance exam.

#### **IGCSE**

**Pre-IGCSE** students will take English, Maths, Science and French entrance exams.

**IGCSE students** will take entrance exams in English, Maths, Combined Science, French, and critical thinking skills.

#### **A-Level**

A-Level students will take entrance exams based on the courses that the student(s) wishes to take in A-Level. A-Level students must submit the IGCSE/O-Level results.

The entrance exam will be held on **June 26th, 2024, at 8:30 A.M. SHARP**. Students who do not arrive on time will be prohibited from taking the exam.

### Admissions Requirements:

1. For upper IGCSE students: the student should have completed JHS Form 3 with BECE results, Pre-IGCSE (Lower IGCSE), or 9<sup>th</sup> grade in American system school.  
(However, if any JHS Form 2 student wishes to apply for Upper IGCSE, the school will determine the level that the student will be put into after the Entrance Exam.)
2. Transfer Student for Senior High School: a grade report and testimonial letter should be submitted from the previous school and payment slips for previous year payments. The placement of the grade also will be determined according to the Entrance Exam.
3. For home school students: the student's record should be submitted and the school will determine the placement of the child according to the Entrance Exam.
4. If the child completed a certain Kindergarten level or Primary School grade, but the child's age is younger than the grade level, then the child's previous school transcript should be submitted and the child should achieve satisfactory level on the Entrance Exam and assessment procedure for that grade.

## **GUIDELINES FOR PAYMENT**

1. All new students must have their full semester fees and others paid before enrolment.
2. Application and admission fees shall be paid only once by new students. These fees are non-refundable.
3. Fees paid in instalments are to be fully paid before the due dates. If not, then the student should stay at home or may be suspended until all fees are fully paid. Students whose fees are not paid will not be allowed to write their exams until all fees are fully paid.
4. Tuition and boarding fee payment should be via direct payment to the school's account (GCB or Calbank) in the child's full name. A copy of the pay-in slip should be submitted to the administration office (Mon.-Fri. 8:30am – 4:00pm) as evidence that fees have been paid. Screenshots of receipts for mobile transfers can be sent to the office number: 054 082 7530 on WhatsApp for an official receipt to be issued. We accept cash or momo payment for uniforms and textbooks.
5. A semester's written notice (three months) is required prior to the withdrawal of a student. If no such notice is given, one-third of the academic year's tuition must be paid in lieu thereof.
6. Where a student is absent for a full semester or more than a semester in an academic year, if the parent wishes that a slot is kept for their child, then the tuition fee must be paid in full for the period of absence; otherwise the student will be considered as a new entry student and will be admitted when a vacancy occurs on payment of new admission fee.
7. Fees are non-refundable in case of expulsion or in any other circumstance.
8. External examination fees are determined by the Examination Board and are to be paid separately.
9. Parents/Guardians of international students may be required to pay a deposit for medical care.
10. The School Board reserves the right to review the fees at the beginning of the school year.
11. A 10% penalty shall be levied on late payments.
