# **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Upper IGCSE: the student should have completed JHS 3 with BECE results, Pre-IGCSE (Lower IGCSE), or 9th grade in American system school.
- 2. Transfer Students: a grade report and testimonial letter should be submitted from the previous school with fee payment slips/receipts for previous year. The placement of the grade will be determined according to the Entrance Exam and Interview.
- 3. Home School Students: the student's record should be submitted, and the school will determine the placement of the child according to the Entrance Exam.
- 4. If the child has completed Kindergarten or Primary School grade but is younger than the grade level, then the child's previous school transcript should be submitted, and the child should achieve a satisfactory level on the Entrance Exam and assessment procedure for that grade.

# **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

- 1. Fill out and submit the application form and all other necessary forms with all required documents.
- 2. The school will notify you about the arrangements for an entrance exam after reviewing the application.
- 3. An interview with the Principal will be schedule after reviewing the results of the entrance exams.
- 4. Based on the entrance exam and interview results, the ward(s) placement in the school will be determined.
- 5. The student(s) will be placed on the waiting list until a space opens up in case the grade of admission is full.
- 6. Parents will need to complete the following after the interview:
  - · Sign "Parent's Contract."
  - Pay the Admissions Fee.
  - Pay one semester's tuition and all other fees.
- 7. When all fees and documentation have been received, admission letters will be issued to parents.

# **ENTRANCE EXAM**

## Pre-nursery to Nursery I (18 months to 24 months)

Pre-nursery and Nursery school students will take an entrance assessment.

## Montessori Kindergarten (3 years to 5 years)

KG students will take a Literacy Skills and Math Concepts assessment and Life Skills.

## **Primary School (Cambridge)**

Primary School students will take English and Math entrance exam.

#### IGCSE

Pre-IGCSE students will take English, Math, Science and French entrance exams.

IGCSE students will take entrance exams in English, Math, Combined Science, French, and critical thinking skills.

#### A-Level

Applicants can apply now and submit their IGCSE/GCE O'Level results later. Interviews will be conducted for qualified applicants after their results have been reviewed.

The entrance exam will be held on **June 26th, 2024**, at **8:30am PROMPT** at the school's premises. Students who do not arrive on time will be prohibited from taking the exam.
